**The minimum threshold level of assessment is determined by the fact that the student has certain knowledge provided for in the work program of the academic discipline, possesses the main provisions studied at the level that is defined as minimum acceptable. Using the main

theoretical provisions, the student explains with difficulty the rules for solving practical/calculation tasks of the discipline. Performance of practical/control/individual tasks is significantly formalized: there is compliance with the algorithm, but there is no deep understanding of work and relationships with other disciplines.

The maximum number of points is 60. The minimum number of points scored by a student is 60% of the maximum number of points obtained during the study of the discipline - 36 points.

7. Tools for diagnosing learning outcomes and current forms and final control

When organizing the educational process at the Polis National University, students, teachers, methodologists, administration and other participants in the educational process act in accordance with: Regulations on the Organization of the Educational Process at the Polis National University, Regulations on the Internal System of Higher Education Quality Assurance at the Polis National University, Regulations on Procedure implementation of the right to academic mobility of participants in the educational process, Regulations on academic integrity, prevention and detection of plagiarism, Regulations on recognition of learning results obtained in non-formal education, Concepts of development of inclusive education.

Academic integrity. Students' papers are expected to be their own original research or reasoning. Lack of references to used sources, fabrication of written off sources, interference in the work of other students are examples of academic dishonesty. The detection of signs of academic dishonesty in a student's written work is grounds for its failure by the teacher, regardless of the scale of plagiarism or deception.

For classes, students come to the classroom on time in accordance with the current schedule (in case of missing classes, an explanatory note is submitted to the dean's office). During classes, students: do not eat food or chewing gum; do not leave the classroom without the teacher's permission; do not prevent the teacher from conducting classes. During knowledge control, students: are prepared in accordance with the requirements of this course; rely only on their own knowledge (do not look for other sources of information); do not disturb others; fulfill all the requirements of teachers regarding knowledge control.

The teacher, in turn: provides an atmosphere of creative, interested attitude of students to the academic discipline that he teaches; forms a spirit of mutual understanding and benevolence in classes, excludes formalism and elements of unprincipledness in the educational process; when conducting classes, the requirements of labor discipline and the training schedule are observed.

The final control of study results and students' competencies in the academic discipline is carried out on the basis of a semester exam in the form of PC testing. Examination tests cover the curriculum of the academic discipline. The purpose of the exam is to check the student's understanding of the program material as a whole, the logic and relationships between individual sections, the ability to use it to solve practical problems, etc. Test questions have a theoretical and practical direction, which involve solving typical professional tasks of a

specialist at the workplace and allow diagnosing the level of training of the student and the level of his competence in the academic discipline.

The minimum possible number of points received by a student in the case of passing the exam is 24. The maximum possible number of points received on the exam is 40. The final points for the exam consist of the sum of points for the answers to the test questions, rounded to a whole number.

Control methods:

Lecture: preliminary oral or written survey, frontal survey, selective oral survey.

Practical session: interview, discussion, brainstorming, oral and written survey, testing, problem solving, defense of reports (abstracts), dialogue, professional dictation, written module work (intermediate control).

Independent work of students: checking the synopsis, checking the answers to problematic questions, surveying during a practical session, defending an individual creative-scientific task. Current control of conducting practical classes, working off academic debts.

Modular control - includes checking the mastery of the material of selective course topics in accordance with the thematic plan by performing independent and practical tasks, conducting borderline certification. The final grade in the discipline is calculated as the sum of the points obtained during the exam and the points obtained during the current control of the cumulative system.
